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## A six-month extension of the custom milling agreement was signed by Abcourt and Richmont Mines Inc

**Mr. Renaud Hinse, President and Chief Executive Officer of Abcourt Mines Inc. (TSX-V: ABI, Berlin: AML-BE and Frankfurt Stock Exchanges: AML-FF) (“Abcourt”)** is pleased to announce that an extension of the custom milling of the Elder gold mineralized material at Usine Camflo Inc, a fully-owned subsidiary of Richmont Mines Inc, was signed on the first day of February last. The milling of a batch was started on the same day. This agreement is for a six-month period, from January to June 2016, and it is renewable. Abcourt is committed to deliver a minimum of 50,000 tonnes of gold mineralized material to the Camflo mill during the milling period.

Abcourt Mines Inc. is an exploration and development company with strategically located properties in northwestern Quebec, Canada. The Elder property has gold resources (2012), the Abcourt-Barvue Project has silver-zinc ore reserves (2007) and resources (2012) and the Aldermac property has historical copper-zinc resources. The reported reserves and resources are considered as current mineral reserves and resources. Abcourt is now focused on the Elder and Abcourt-Barvue projects with Elder as the first priority. At the same time, the Company is working on other projects (Aldermac, Vezza, Jonpol and Vendome) to increase its mineral resources inventory. A resource calculation was completed in July, 2012, for the Elder property. A positive PEA report was prepared on Elder in the Fall of 2012 by Roche Limited, Consulting Group. A positive feasibility study was completed by GENIVAR in 2007 on the Abcourt-Barvue Project.
